PERT is a project management planning tool used to calculate the amount of time it will take to realistically finish a project. PERT stands for Program Evaluation Review Technique. PERT charts are tools used to plan tasks within a project – making it easier to schedule and coordinate team members accomplishing the work. Critical Path: creating faster flow. Developed alongside PERT in the late s, Critical Path Method (CPM) also centers around a flowchart of events and tasks. Together, the PERT and Critical Path methods had the biggest impact on the field of project management since the Gantt chart.
