This is why we know Anne Frank by her real name rather than as Anne Aulis (her original choice of a pseudonym) or as Anne Robin (the name Anne later chose for herself). Anne chose the pseudonyms Betty Robin for Margot Frank, Frederik Robin for Otto Frank, and Nora Robin for Edith Frank. Fifteen-year-old Anne Frank was born in Frankfurt, Germany to Edith and Otto Frank. Anne also had a sister named Margot who was three years older. They were an upper-middle-class German-Jewish family living in a religiously diverse neighborhood. Most people who visit the Anne Frank House in Amsterdam know the basic info of Anne Frank: Anne Frank was a Jewish girl, born in Germany, who fled Nazi-Germany in .

Anne Frank was just one of the many children traumatized at the time of the holocaust. Her diary gives examples of what life for a Jewish family in living in hiding living in Nazi occupied Europe.
